

# GaSDF DOG TAG FORM

Dog tags are a way to identify you if the worst case scenario were to happen. They are a way for you to communicate when you are unable to.

Any personal that has an allergy or special medical conditions needs to make sure they have 1(one) ORANGE or RED tag attached to their chain in addition to their 2 (two) inscribed tags. This indicates that there is a medical precaution that the medic must be made aware of. Fill out Line 4 Section A, B, & C.

Line 1: Last Name, First Name, Middle Initial

Line 2: SS#

Line 3: Religious Affiliation

Line 4: Allergies, Blood Type
