

# GASDF FEMA TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

---

The following [FEMA courses](#) are to be completed by all GSDF personnel **within one year of joining** (required IAW GSDF 624-1 paragraph 6.i.):

- **IS-5** - An Introduction to Hazardous Materials
- **IS-22** - Are You Ready? An In-depth Guide to Citizen Preparedness (replaces Emergency Preparedness USA which has been discontinued)
- **IS-100** - Introduction to Incident Command System (ICS) (replaces Basic Incident Command System (ICS) which has been discontinued)
- **IS 208** - State Disaster Management (replaces Emergency Response to Terrorism which has been discontinued)
- **IS-275** - The EOC's Role in Community Preparedness, Response and Recovery Activities

The following additional courses are required for attendance to BNCOC, ANCOG, or OCS:

- **IS-317** - Introduction to Community Emergency Response Teams (CERT)
- **IS-700** - National Incident Management System (NIMS), An Introduction
- **IS-800** - National Response Plan (NRP), an Introduction

The following courses that are suggested for consideration:

- **IS-288** - The Role of Voluntary Agencies in Emergency Management
- **IS-292** - Disaster Basics

It is recommended that all senior NCO's and Officers 0-3 and above complete the following courses (courses in the Professional Development Series in which a certificate of completion is issued):
